COI Mini-Grants	<ul> <li>Round one of the mini-grants will be wrapping up soon.</li> <li>Projects are supposed to be completed by the end of May and final reports are due early June.</li> <li>The Biking for Health project is on target, although we are still waiting to confirm dates for the bike rodeos.</li> <li>Bayside has encountered challenges with the intersection mural since the City of San Diego currently does not have a process in place for these types of projects.</li> <li>Bayside is working to confirm the design, with community feedback, and then it will have to be submitted to the Arts and Culture Commission for approval.</li> <li>Once the design is approved, Bayside can apply for the permits.</li> <li>The RFA for round two of funding will be available in May.
