<p><b>1. San Diego Milk Bank App- Dr. Lisa Stellwagen and Alex Diaz</b></p>	<p><b>San Diego Mother' Milk Bank</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>26 milk banks in US and only 1 in California (San Jose).</li> <li>Donated primarily by working mothers, NICU mothers and women with oversupply of milk.</li> <li>Milk is cultured and pasteurized to kill off viruses and bacteria prior to distribution.</li> <li>Currently working together with the San Diego Blood Bank for milk donations and delivery and HMBANA for milk processing.</li> <li>Mothers can go into her community and donate/ utilize saved milk similar to a blood bank.</li> <li>Goal is to collect milk on an ongoing basis.</li> <li>Potential partners for the Milk Bank project include:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>San Diego maternity hospitals and NICUs, WIC, San Diego County Breastfeeding Coalition, Community Pediatricians and Obstetricians, San Diego Childhood Obesity Initiative (CDPH)</li> <li>Potential national partners: AAP, ACOG, CDC</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b>San Diego Mothers' Milk Bank App</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Free smartphone app for breastfeeding mothers in San Diego region.</li> <li>Currently directing donations to San Jose Mothers' Milk Bank.</li> <li>Mobile messaging to mothers regarding milk shortages, breastfeeding education, and neighborhood alerts via geolocation which provides nearest hospitals and clinics.</li> <li>Blood banks will be tagged on the map and date of arrival will be identified.</li> <li>App will provide a news feed similar to Facebook and open forums to allow mothers to share their concerns, updates, and support.</li> <li>The Milk Bank and app is still under development and is tentatively projected to launch January 2018.</li> </ul> <p><b>Ways that COI can support</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Partner with the Early Childhood Domain to share messaging and resources for parents.</li> <li>Promote app on social media, newsletter, and on the COI website.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dean put in 2-1-1 messaging for mothers interested in donating.</li> <li>Invite Dr. Stellwagen to speak at an Early Childhood Domain meeting.</li> </ul>

The review will continue into the next meeting.</li> </ul> <p><b>2-1-1 Project Update</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The project received funding from ACE to certify 8 health coaches.</li> <li>Project will assist referred clients ages 2- 11 that are within the 85 percentile of being overweight or obese.</li> <li>Services will span through 8 calls over a period of 10 weeks.</li> <li>Pilot will begin in January 2018.</li> </ul>
