1. San Diego Milk Bank App- Dr. Lisa Stellwagen and Alex Diaz	 San Diego Mother' Milk Bank 26 milk banks in US and only 1 in California (San Jose). Donated primarily by working mothers, NICU mothers and women with oversupply of milk. Milk is cultured and pasteurized to kill off viruses and bacteria prior to distribution. Currently working together with the San Diego Blood Bank for milk donations and delivery and HMBANA for milk processing. Mothers can go into her community and donate/ utilize saved milk similar to a blood bank. Goal is to collect milk on an ongoing basis. Potential partners for the Milk Bank project include: San Diego maternity hospitals and NICUs, WIC, San Diego County Breastfeeding Coalition, Community Pediatricians and Obstetricians, San Diego Childhood Obesity Initiative (CDPH) Potential national partners: AAP, ACOG, CDC San Diego Mothers' Milk Bank App Free smartphone app for breastfeeding mothers in San Diego region. Currently directing donations to San Jose Mothers' Milk Bank. Mobile messaging to mothers regarding milk shortages, breastfeeding education, and neighborhood alerts via geolocation which provides nearest hospitals and clinics. Blood banks will be tagged on the map and date of arrival will be identified. App will provide a news feed similar to Facebook and open forums to allow mothers to share their concerns, updates, and support. The Milk Bank and app is still under development and is tentatively projected to launch January 2018.
