1. COI Forum	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Every year the COI hosts three forums a year including two that are more focused on capacity building. This year, the intent is to host a forum in March or early April that is more set up like a Luncheon for a more casual atmosphere that is better for networking opportunities. The forum will be targeted towards AAP, San Diego County, Physicians, Community Clinics, Insurance Companies, Kaiser, CBOs, WIC, and other similar organizations. The intent of the luncheon will be focused on Healthcare Domain updates, highlighting accomplishments, looking at social determinants of health, and the AAP survey and what the group can do. The details for the luncheon are in the infant stages and have not been finalized. 	
2. Domain Recruitment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cheri announced to the workgroup of her retirement happening next year. Cheri has been involved since the beginning of COI and her participation will be greatly missed. With this, the workgroup asks, what is the roll of the Healthcare Domain for the future? An idea that will bring more people to the table is inviting healthcare providers and community clinic representatives to attend upcoming workgroup meetings and potentially presenting about their organization and seeing where the domain can provide support. Kim mentioned that she is in connection with Juan Estrada, a member of the community outreach committee and hosts Molina’s quarterly meetings. To attend one of these meetings would be a great base to start more connections for the workgroup. Kim shared that WIC and UC Davis Lactation Center have created through the Baby Behavior Campaign, informational and educational mini-book called, “Getting to know your Baby: Birth to 6 months”, that helps mothers become more aware of baby cues and how to identify what their baby needs. A goal of the HC Domain will be to help get a larger audience for Kim’s breastfeeding trainings for healthcare and childcare providers, hospitals, nurseries, and birthing centers.
