<p><b>1. Workplan Finalization</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The workgroup revisited the workplan with the intension of finalizing the document. They reviewed each of the objectives and concurrent activities and action steps.</li> <li>• Within the second objective, as an activity the workgroup would like to work directly with OBs, community clinics, WIC and others to identify ways to reduce barriers to promote continued breastfeeding.</li> <li>• The workgroup proposed hosting a seminar opportunity to capture the target population in a more unique way.</li> <li>• Historically, the workgroup has tried reaching out to OBs phone and online surveys and even considered facilitating focus groups and received very little feedback. To get a different perspective, Dean asked the health plan representatives if they had any thoughts on how to attract more OB participation.</li> <li>• One way to reach out is potentially getting together with the Health Education workgroup and putting on a seminar targeting OBs specifically health promoting and breastfeeding is a requirement of Care 1<sup>st</sup> by the state and seems like these efforts will align nicely.</li> <li>• If this seminar is able to work out as planned, the ideal time frame would be sometime in the Fall. August 1-7 is Breastfeeding Awareness Week and the whole month of August is National Breastfeeding Awareness Month and this would be a great time. As far as potential speaker ideas, Going to the Breastfeeding Coalition and seeing if they have identified speakers, such as Nancy Wight from UCSD.</li> <li>• Should these plans follow through, those who are interested in assisting with the seminar will be added to the workplan.</li> <li>• Plans have not been finalized and are currently in the developmental stages. This is the first app to go live with the Medicaid population in Southern California.</li> </ul>
