Domain Direction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Look at who is attending the domain and find out what each organization’s priorities are and how the domain can support those efforts through adding items to the domain workplan. • One of the top priorities for the Government Domain is supporting active transportation efforts through combining Vision Zero concepts and what it entails with other cities and municipalities. • Hugo is very involved with the HealthyCities, Healthy Residence project. A three year project which started in March 2017. Contracted three CBOs in different cities which are tasked with advancing two citywide policies related advancing healthy food environments and the other in active transportation, in addition to completing an environmental change. There is technical assistance around active transportation and capacity building provided through Circulate San Diego and HHSa has capacity to provide assistance with place making and food environment. • The San Diego bike coalition is in the beginning stages of creating a community bike center located in Liberty Station. The center will showcase the history of cycling throughout San Diego as well as provide a meeting center for cyclists and the community. Something that the workgroup can potentially adopt as an action item for future meetings is to work on crafting a survey to send out to local cities to get their input on the center. • Chula Vista is starting to do outreach throughout the community, particularly intergenerational populations for the bike and pedestrian master plan update. • The workgroup worked on identifying a strategic outreach plan which will help with engaging new organizations and partners around the table. • SANDAG Public Health Committee that was formed to provide public health input into the whole plan for San Diego.
