The COI staff will continue to do this to help increase the awareness of other current domain work and potentially increase cross-domain collaboration.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The COI has been working with Healthy San Diego on the Baby/Toddler Behavior Training Forum which is planned for March 20 at 2-1-1 Connections Center with presenter Dr. Jane Heinig from UC Davis. Something that has been discussed in previous workgroup meetings is providing a similar forum training for early childcare providers. The workgroup continued the discussion.

Considering Jane is available for the entire day, an additional training for early childcare providers are would need to be later in the evening. Worplan Updates</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Olivia Nolan presented on the findings from the Higher Education Survey. • There were a total of 13 participants (12 who are currently teaching and 1 department chair) from a total of five different community colleges including Mira Costa, Southwest, Palomar, Miramar, and San Diego City College. • It was found that the majority of those surveyed are interested in receiving supplemental resources in the areas of physical activity, nutrition and healthy eating, and childhood obesity to use in their courses. • With the survey completed, some next steps were discussed and potentially developing a recourse portal that would be housed on the COI website for a way for professors to easily access content. This is also an area of focus in the domain workplan. Things that were suggested to be included in the page include the following.
