1. Announcements	 YMCA has been in contact with Kaiser about doing Wellness Champion work in National City which has the highest obesity rates in the county. More updates to follow. 2. COI Updates	 The Annual COI Strategic Planning Retreat took place on February 8th. A main topic for discussion was on future areas of focus for the COI.
