1. 2. COI Updates	 Camellia provided an overview of the latest childhood obesity data for San Diego County public schools from the 2017-2018 school year Over 1 in 3 kids were overweight or obese (34.1%) This data indicates little change in recent years and highlights the need to explore addressing root causes of childhood obesity such as housing, poverty, environmental factors, and access to services The group discussed next steps for the release of this data The COI is holding a community forum on childhood obesity prevention and the latest data on June 13 from 4-6 p.m. at Olivewood Gardens and Learning Center in National City. 5210, the COI's health messaging, will be on display at the San Diego County Fair in June where kids and families will have a chance to participate in a scavenger hunt to earn free 5210 giveaways!
