COI Updates</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Camellia provided an overview of the latest childhood obesity data for San Diego County public schools from the 2017-2018 school year               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Over 1 in 3 kids were overweight or obese (34.1%)</li> <li>This data indicates little change in recent years and highlights the need to explore addressing root causes of childhood obesity such as housing, poverty, environmental factors, and access to services</li> <li>The group discussed next steps for the release of this data</li> </ol> </li> <li>The COI is holding a community forum on childhood obesity prevention and the latest data on June 13 from 4-6 p.m. at Olivewood Gardens and Learning Center in National City.</li> <li>5210, the COI's health messaging, will be on display at the San Diego County Fair in June where kids and families will have a chance to participate in a scavenger hunt to earn free 5210 giveaways!
