Children’s System of Care Presentation</b>  Yael Koenig, LCSW</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Healthcare Domain workgroup has had interest in infusing a behavioral health component to the workgroup moving forward as mental health is a known factor that intertwines with obesity.</li> <li>Yael Koenig with the County of San Diego Children, Youth &amp; Families Behavioral Health Systems presented to the domain and shared services offered a potential collaboration opportunities.</li> <li>The Behavioral Health Services (BHS) Division provides mental health and alcohol or other drug services for children, youth, families, adults, and older adults.</li> <li>BHS promotes recovery and well-being through prevention, treatment, and intervention, and integrated services for both mental illness and substance issues.</li> <li>There are several branches of services under BHS including: Substance use disorder services, Adult and Older Adult services, Children, Youth and Families services, Drug Medi-Cal organized delivery systems, and several other services.</li> <li>The Children, Youth and Families (CYF) section of Behavioral Health Services aids children and adolescents who are emotionally disturbed, and their families. They offer a wide variety of services, from early intervention to residential services.
