COI Updates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Camellia gave an overview of award winners from the COI’s April Mix & Mingle event (i.e., San Diego Unified School District, Dr. Shaila Serpas, and YMCA CRS) • Of the five SSB-related bills introduced at the state-level this legislative session, only one (warning labels) is still under consideration <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The soda tax has been moved to a 2-year bill and will be reconsidered in 2020 • The COI submitted a budget ask letter to the City of San Diego in April to encourage funding for fixing dangerous intersections, SRTS, a grant writer to go after ATP funding, and more • Camellia gave a brief presentation on the latest childhood obesity data in San Diego County from the 2017-2018 school year highlighting that rates haven’t changed much (34.1% overweight and obesity for 5th, 7th, and 9th graders) and inequities play a large role
