Announcements	 Chula Vista is working on a healthier and sustainable meeting policy including healthier options at city meetings later this summer Jessica mentioned Eric Batch, the Vice President of Advocacy with the American Heart Association, will be back in San Diego in the fall and can participate in meetings with elected officials 	
COI Updates	 Camellia gave an update on the June 13 forum at Olivewood Gardens in National City, which had ~50 attendees who learned about the latest childhood obesity data and community and policy solutions 	
Obesity Data Release & Report	 The COI is planning to release new childhood obesity data for San Diego County as part of Childhood Obesity Awareness Month (COAM) in September The new report emphasizes the continuing high rates of childhood obesity and the importance of focusing on inequities Current plans for COAM include a press release and press conference tentative for September 12 at the Jackie Robinson YMCA as well as 5210 messaging and giveaways at YMCA branches and various partner sites The Government Domain discussed other opportunities for the data release such as: Presenting at Live Well meetings and getting the UCSD Youth Advisory Council involved Working with Safe Destination Nights and active transportation advocacy groups in Fallbrook As part of the new data release, the COI is creating an infographic that goes over key highlights from the report The goal is for each domain to provide key recommendations for action within that domain that will help build on progress and encourage new strategies 	Johanna Connect COI staff w/ individual in charge of SD Nights Send contact information for leads working to advocate for active transportation in Fallbrook
